

P&T Process: AD Role

1. Provide direction and leadership for the professional development of all Extension personnel assigned Community Development duties;
2. Provide leadership in developing core programmatic curriculum;
3. Encourage and engage in applied scholarly and creative work in support of community development programs and professionals;
4. Identify, secure, and administer financial support for Community Development programs and initiatives;

P&T Process: AD Role

1. Promote effective teamwork among all Community Development professionals and create an environment conducive to entrepreneurialism;
2. Represent OSU Extension in addressing community development issues at the local, state, national, and international levels;
3. Work with Department Chairs, College Deans, and Unit Leaders to identify potential interdisciplinary and multi-programmatic efforts with other departments, colleges, agencies and organizations engaged in resourcing community development programs.
