Apple Cutie Pies



INGREDIENTS:

2 tbsp Butter

3 Granny Smith apples, finely chopped

1/4 c Sugar

1/4 c Brown Sugar

1 tbsp Cinnamon

½ tbsp Ground Nutmeg

1 tbsp Cornstarch

Juice of ½ Lemon

All-purpose Flour, for work surface

2 Refrigerated pie crusts

1 c caramel (warmed if necessary)

Egg wash, for brushing

2 tbsp Cinnamon Sugar, for sprinkling

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees, line baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Make apple pie filling: In a large pot over medium heat, melt butter. Add apples and cook until beginning to soften, then add sugars, cinnamon, and nutmeg then stir. Let cook for a few minutes more, then add cornstarch and lemon juice. Remove from heat and let slightly cool.
- 3. Roll out refrigerated pie crusts on a floured work surface. Slice one into long, ½" thick lattice strips. Set aside.
- 4. Spread the second pie crust with caramel, then top with apple pie filling. Top half the lattice strips going one direction, then the remaining half going the other direction.
- 5. Use a cookie or biscuit cutter to cut small rounds. Transfer to parchment-lined baking sheet and discard scraps.
- 6. Brush cookies with egg wash and sprinkle with cinnamon sugar.
- 7. Bake until golden brown, 28 30 minutes.


